

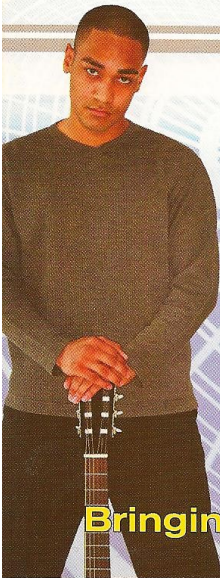


The Sound Futures Programme help young people and adults to develop their creative expression and self-esteem through participatory music and cross arts sessions.
